

READ ISAIAH 5

Write out this week's Scripture Memory Verse: [Isaiah 5:20](#)

Q1: LOOK DOWN

Read [Isaiah 5:1-7](#). List below what the Beloved does for His vineyard. Who is the Beloved? Who is the vineyard? What did the LORD expect from His people? What did He see? What will happen to the vineyard?

Q2: LOOK OUT



What has the LORD done for us as a country? As a church? How have we responded?

Q3: LOOK IN

What has the LORD done for you in your life? Take some time to be quiet before Him and ask Him to remind you of the ways He has taken care of you. Write down what He shows you below. How have you responded? As you pray today, thank Him for His incredible kindness and love.



READ ISAIAH 5

Write out this week's Scripture Memory Verse: [Isaiah 5:20](#)

Q1: LOOK DOWN

Read [Isaiah 5:8-12](#). List the two “woes” that Isaiah has declared. Who are they for? What do those people do? What has the LORD said? What are the people who pursue drink not doing?

Q2: LOOK OUT



READ ISAIAH 5

Write out this week's Scripture Memory Verse: [Isaiah 5:20](#)

Q1: LOOK DOWN

Read [Isaiah 5:13-17](#). Highlight the words *therefore*, *but* and *then*. What is going to happen to God's people? Why? What will happen to the LORD?

Q2: LOOK OUT



Hosea was a prophet to Israel around the same time as Isaiah's early years. [Hosea 4:1-6](#) has a similar message. How do we reject knowledge today?

Q3: LOOK IN

Read [John 17:3, 8, 20, 21, 23, 25](#). What is eternal life? How do you know Jesus? How do you continue to get to know God? How do you make Him known?



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Write out this week's Scripture Memory Verse: [Isaiah 5:20](#)

Q1: LOOK DOWN 

Read [Isaiah 5:18-24](#). Highlight the word *woe*. What are the sins in this passage? List them below. Read [v.24](#). What is the reason they will be judged?


Q2: LOOK OUT



Read [Isaiah 5:20](#). How is that seen in our society today? What things that are evil are now called good?

Q3: LOOK IN

Is there any area in your life that you are rejecting the word of God and “substituting darkness for light and light for darkness”? How can you make the word of God the authority you stand on?



READ ISAIAH 5

Write out this week's Scripture Memory Verse: [Isaiah 5:20](#)

Q1: LOOK DOWN

Read Isaiah [5:24-30](#). Highlight the word *therefore*. What else will happen to the people of Judah according to [verse 24](#)? Why? What will the LORD do? (See [v.25](#) and [26](#)).

Q2: LOOK OUT



Look back at the beginning of chapter 5 and think about the relationship God has between Himself and the people of Judah. How does He feel about His people? How do you think our sin affects God today?

Q3: LOOK IN

Even though this chapter talks about the sin and judgement of Judah, you see glimpses of God's heart for His people. What has God shown you this week about His love for you?



TYING IT ALL TOGETHER

What impacted you the most within this week's passage of Isaiah? What one thing will you do this week to apply a lesson learned from the Book of Isaiah? Who will keep you accountable?

WEEK 3 GROUP DISCUSSION

MAIN IDEA:

LEAN IN

Have you ever been excited to do something for someone, only it didn't end up the way you thought it would? What happened? Share your story with your Life Group.

LOOK DOWN & LIVE IT OUT (OUT/IN)

1. Look Down (question 1, day 4):

Read Isaiah 5:18-24. Notice the word *woe*. What are the sins in this passage? What would they look like today? Read v.24. What is the reason they will be judged?

2. Look Out (question 2, day 4):

Read Isaiah 5:20. How is that seen in our society today? What things that are evil are now called good?

3. Look In (question 3, day 2):

How sensitive are you to the deeds and works of the LORD? You were to ask yourself each day this week, "Where did I see Jesus today?" Share with your group some of the ways or places you saw Jesus. Was there anything surprising?

4. In Your Own Words: Share with your group one action you will take in the next week to continue to walk in the light of the Lord. How can you keep each other accountable?
