

READ ISAIAH 9

Write out this week's Scripture Memory Verse: [Isaiah 9:2](#)

Q1: LOOK DOWN

Read [Isaiah 9:1-6](#). Circle the 4 names given to the Son. What do these names tell us about who the “Son” is and what He will do? (For further study read [Isaiah 22:22 – 24](#); [Psalm 72](#))



Q2: LOOK OUT

Where in our culture today do you see the need for a Wonderful Counselor? Might God? Everlasting Father? Prince of Peace? Explain.

Q3: LOOK IN

Choose one names of the Son. Why is this an important part of your personal relationship with Jesus? Explain



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Q1: LOOK DOWN 

Read [Isaiah 5:25](#). Underline the repeated phrase in [Isaiah 5:25, 9:12,17 & 21](#). What is the implication? What is the consequence of Israel's sin? (For further study [2 Kings 17:5-17](#))



Q2: LOOK OUT

What is happening in your own community where God’s hand might be outstretched against it?

Q3: LOOK IN

How are you actively praying into these situations? How has God given you His heart for your community?

Q1: LOOK DOWN

What sins does the Lord judge in [Isaiah 9:9-10, 13-21](#)?



Q2: LOOK OUT 

What expectations does God have of His people today? (Hint see [Isaiah 9:8-21](#))

Q3: LOOK IN 

Does what the Lord judges convict you in any areas of your life?

Q1: LOOK DOWN

List the words used to describe wickedness in [Isaiah 9:18-21](#). What is God describing in these verses? What does He specifically say about how people treat one another?



Q2: LOOK OUT

How do God's people mistreat one another today? How does that affect our witness with those who do not yet know Jesus?
Read [John 13:34-35](#)

Q3: LOOK IN

Who is God laying on your heart that you need to ask forgiveness from? How has this situation caused you to walk in darkness?

2. **Look Out (question 2, day 3):**

What expectations does God have of His people today? (Hint see [Isaiah 9:8-21](#))

3. **Look In (question 3, day 3):**

Does what the Lord judges convict you in any areas of your life?

4. **In Your Own Words:** Have 1 person share their summary of Isaiah 9 and its key message. Have a different person share how this relates to our key theme.
