MAIN IDEA:

LEAN IN

As a Christian, is it wrong to speak to/consult others on the plans we are making? Explain.

LOOK DOWN, LOOK OUT, LOOK IN

1. **Look Down (question 1, day 4):**

Read [Isaiah 30:18-28](#). Compare and Contrast. Using the chart from your homework, discuss what God would do for the people on the left and what God would do to the nations on the right including the verse reference.

2. **Look Out (question 2, day 5):**

When we sin, how does it show a lack of trust in God? How is ‘repentance and rest’ and ‘quietness and trust’ the opposite of this? How can the church be tempted to sin this way, turning to worldly plans and methods for success, advice and direction instead of God? What are the consequences of this, and what is the remedy?

3. **Look In (question 3, day 2):**

[Isaiah 30:10-11](#) has God’s word being written on tablets. How does this shape your approach to writing out God’s Word daily? Has daily writing of His Word impacted you? Share with your group.

4. **In Your Own Words:** Have 1 person share their summary of [Isaiah 30](#) and its key message. Have a different person share how this relates to our key theme. What impact does this have for you personally?

LOOK UP

Pray that...

- God would reveal those areas of your life where you have put your trust in others instead of Him.
- He would give you His heart and His eyes, that you would hear His sighs for His people and obediently engage where He is asking you to.
- Meditate and reflect on Psalm 121 as you pray its truths over your life. Replace *your* with *my*, *me* as appropriate.
