

READ ISAIAH 42

Write out this week's Scripture Memory Verse: [Isaiah 42:6, 16](#) (two verses this week!)

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Q1: LOOK DOWN 

Read [Isaiah 42:1-4](#). Who is speaking here? (You will have to look back into [chapter 41](#)). List everything you learn about the Servant. Who is the Servant in these verses? Read [Matt. 12:15-21](#). What do these verses tell you about the Servant?

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**Q2: LOOK OUT**

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What is the Servant to bring forth? To whom will He bring it? How will He do it? Do we as a church (locally and globally) wait expectantly for His instruction? How do we try to establish justice on our own?

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**Q3: LOOK IN**

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Have you been discouraged by any lack of justice you have seen? How can this passage encourage you? Is God asking you to wait on Him, or has He given you instructions to act? How do you know?

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**Q2: LOOK OUT**

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Read [Isaiah 49:6](#), [Luke 2:25-33](#) and [Acts 26:23](#). How has [Isaiah 42:6](#) been fulfilled in Jesus?

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**Q3: LOOK IN**

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Who told you about the light? Who told you about salvation? Who have you told about the light? Who could you tell?

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Write out this week's Scripture Memory Verse: Isaiah 42:6, 16

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Q1: LOOK DOWN

Read Isaiah 42:10-13. What are the people to do? Who is to do it? What else do you learn about the LORD? How does that compare with how the Servant is described in verses 1-4? See Ex. 15:3 and Rev. 19:11.

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**Q2: LOOK OUT**

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Read [Ps. 98:1-3](#). How has God “revealed His righteousness in the sight of the nations”? How have “the ends of the earth seen the salvation of our God”?

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**Q3: LOOK IN**

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What can you praise God for today? For the rest of this week, fill in this chart with things you have praised Him about. It could be a verse you read, song you have sung, or something you have seen Him do.

**READ ISAIAH 42**

Write out this week’s Scripture Memory Verse: [Isaiah 42:6, 16](#)



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**Q1: LOOK DOWN**

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Read [Isaiah 42:8,13-17](#). Notice all the “I will...” statements. What will the Lord do? Who will NOT do it? What should the people do?

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**Q2: LOOK OUT** 

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Where have you seen God act after waiting for a long time? What did He do? How did His light shine in the darkness?

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**Q3: LOOK IN**

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Read [Isaiah 42:16](#), [Ps. 94:14](#), and [Luke 1:78-79](#). What things in your life are unknown, dark or rough right now? How can you turn one of these verses into a prayer about your situation? Write it below in your own words.

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READ ISAIAH 42

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Q1: LOOK DOWN

Read [Isaiah 42:18-25](#). Who is the servant in this passage? (See [Is. 41:8](#)). What has this servant done? How are they described? What do you learn about the LORD?

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**Q2: LOOK OUT**

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Compare the Servant from [v.1-9](#) with the servant in [v. 18-25](#). What would you need to do to not only see but also observe, and to have ears open that actually hear? How do you recognize what God is doing around you?

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**Q3: LOOK IN** 

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Do you see yourself as a servant of God? Read [Isaiah 42:1, 6](#). What relationship did the Servant have with God? Do you have a relationship with the Lord like that? Paul and Barnabas took [Isaiah 42:6](#) as a command in [Acts 13:46-48](#). Is this a command for us today?

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## WEEK 7 GROUP DISCUSSION

### MAIN IDEA:

### LEAN IN

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In your day-to-day life, do you find it easy to talk to others about Jesus or hard? What makes it that way? Share any situations you have encountered with your Life Group.

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### LOOK DOWN & LIVE IT OUT (OUT/IN)

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**1. Look Down (question 1, day 1 and 2):**

Read Isaiah 42:1-9. What do you learn about God from these verses? What will He do for the Servant? What will the Servant do? Who is the Servant?

**2. Look Out (question 2, day 4):**

Where have you seen God act after waiting for a long time? What did He do? How did His light shine in the darkness?

**3. Look In (question 3, day 5):**

Do you see yourself as a servant of God? Read Isaiah 42:1, 6. What relationship did the Servant have with God? Do you have a relationship with the Lord like that? Paul and Barnabas took Isaiah 42:6 as a command in Acts 13:46-48. Is this a command for us today?

**4. In Your Own Words:** Share with your group one action you will take in the next week to continue to walk in the light of the Lord. How can you keep each other accountable?
