JOB DESCRIPTION

Position Overview:

At The Peoples Church, we want our congregation to experience Christ, to be in enriched communities and engage their world. It is to that end that we are seeking a Young Adult Pastor who is passionate about seeing young adults develop their relationship with Jesus and be on mission with Him. While working with a team of volunteer leaders, the Young Adult Pastor will be responsible for the development and oversight of our Young Adult ministry (Impact, age 18-25).

Major Responsibilities:

- Raise a generation of gospel-centered, globally minded Christians.
- Assist in the development and oversight of the young adult ministry budgets.
- Oversee, develop, and grow the ministry to young adults by connecting and interacting with them through regular gatherings, local and global involvement and through Life Groups.
- Strategize, implement, and oversee global efforts for young adults in partnership with our Global Outreach department.
- Recruit, equip, and enable volunteers to share in the leadership of the young adult ministry.
- Seek to integrate young adult ministry into all phases of church life.
- Provide pastoral care and spiritual direction to young adults both in large group and individual settings.
- Participate as needed in the evaluation and development of the overall church ministry.
- Other duties as required.
