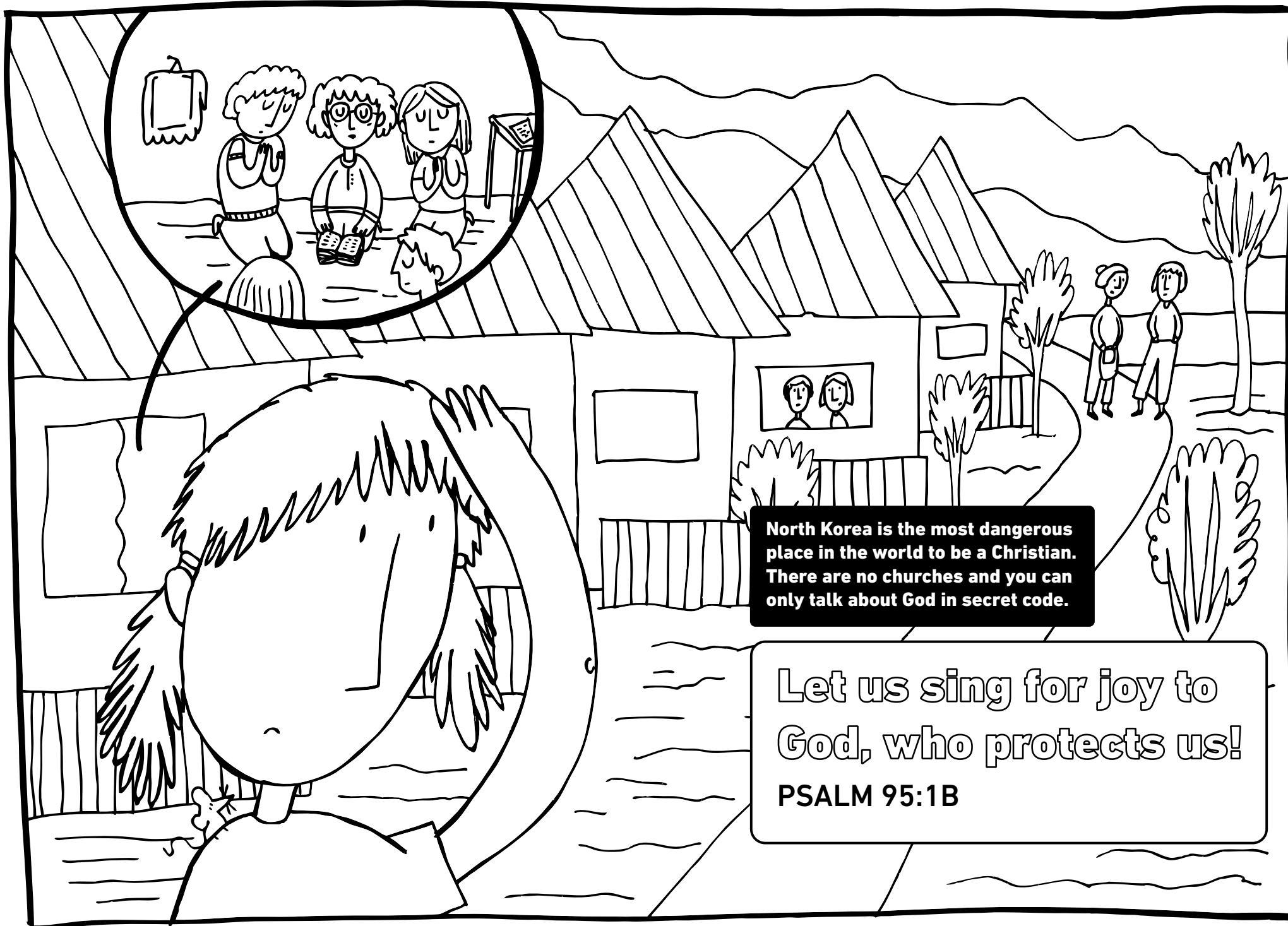
In some countries it's very difficult


PSALM 46:1

that they can't be seen by the planes.



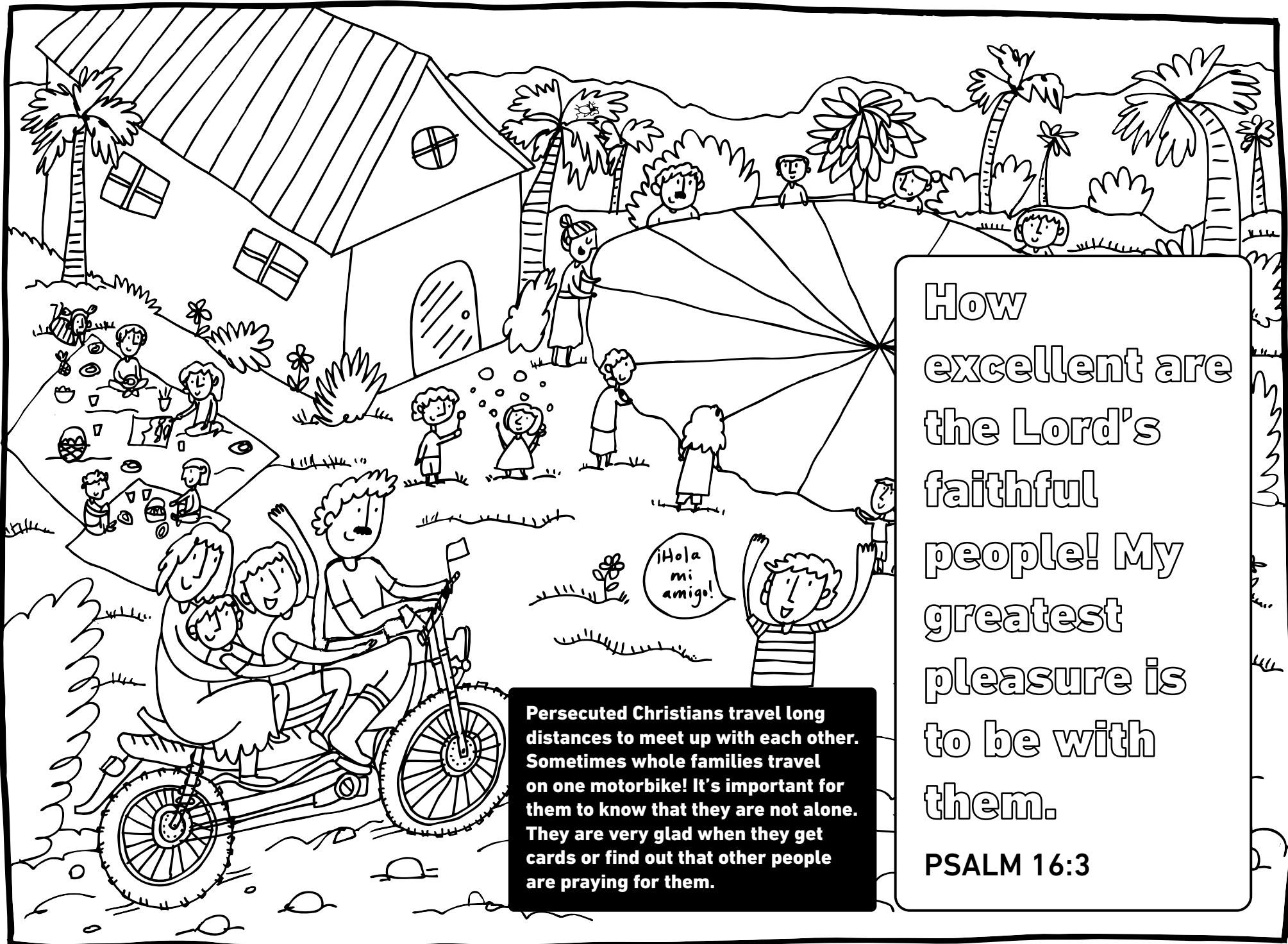
North Korea is the most dangerous place in the world to be a Christian. There are no churches and you can only talk about God in secret code.
