- Bible
- Clothes. PJs. Extra socks.
- Hat. Mitts. Winter stuff.
- Gym shoes.
- Toiletries: shampoo, bodywash, toothbrush, toothpaste, deodorant
- Towel
- Sleeping bag and pillow
- Flashlight
- Reusable water bottle

STUFF NOT TO BRING

- Peanuts/nut products
- Video Games/tablets
- Strong scents/perfume
- Aerosol products (Axe, Hairspray, etc.)
- Tobacco, drugs, alcohol, or weapons

Cell Phones

We do not advise students to bring cell phones to this retreat. Yet, we will allow your students to bring phones as their parents' permit. There are a few rules for the students:

1. Leaders will take phones at curfew and are returned at breakfast.
2. Phone use and rules will be monitored by the leaders, and up to the leader's discretion.
3. We are not responsible for lost, damaged, or stolen phones.

Medication

All medication must be brought in original packaging and given to the staff at registration. Medication is given by the staff at camp and returned when we get back. EPI-Pens and rescue inhalers must be always carried on students.

FAQs

How will my student get there?

We will be taking a bus together supervised by our Junior Youth Leadership Team. The bus leaves from and returns to TPC.

What does the cost include?

Transportation, activities, accommodations, and meals/snacks (Friday late night snack to Sunday lunch).

Where will students be sleeping?

Students will be staying in temperature-controlled cabins.

Where will the leaders be sleeping?

Leaders will be staying in cabins with the students.

Are the rooms assigned?

Yes. Sleeping arrangements will be assigned based on gender and grade. We try our best to put students with someone they know.

Can my student bring a friend?

Absolutely! This is a great way to introduce friends to church. It's also great if your student has never been away from home overnight.

What's on the menu?

The menu is decided by the camp. All food is peanut/nut free facility and we can accommodate most dietary restrictions.

Can students bring their own food?

Pack a peanut/nut free dinner for the bus on Friday. All other meals are provided. Students do not have access to a fridge or microwave.

Can students bring video games or their tablet?

No. All video games consoles, tablets, and like devices will be collected at registration and returned at the end of camp.

How can I contact my student?

Students can bring their cell phones and have access to them. They may be temporarily collected by their leader if they become a distraction. No phones are allowed in the cabins after curfew and returned at breakfast. An emergency phone number will be provided in the final email before the retreat.
